Hi Brian,

For your **donation** it looks out of the ordinary. In the summer we depleted the **Giving match** budget but due to the amazing engagement from partners our leaders decided to increase the budget for the remainder of the fiscal year. Your original **donation** was not matched during this time. However, we went back and honored all of these **donations** in September. So the way it reads is that on 6/30 you made a **donation** of \$1,370 which was directed to the nonprofit but not matched. 
